



Regulations

This refuge is a waterfowl sanctuary and closed to the public October 16 - January 14.
Nature trails are open year-round.

Permitted Activities: February 1 - October 15 Sunrise to Sunset

- Wildlife Observation - by foot, bicycle, or boat
- Pets - must be leashed at all times, except for dogs engaged in hunting activities
- Motorized Boats - at no wake speed
- Fishing - see refuge regulations
- Mushroom, Nut, and Berry Picking
- Waterfowl Hunting - Liverpool Lake Waterfowl Hunting Area, access from Illinois River only

Prohibited Activities:

- Camping
- Alcoholic Beverages
- Campfires
- Fireworks
- Littering
- Swimming
- Off-road Vehicles including ATVs

Vehicles are not allowed past this point.
